Victoria Eve Hardy, age 90, passed away on Saturday, September 10, 2022 in Bismarck, ND. 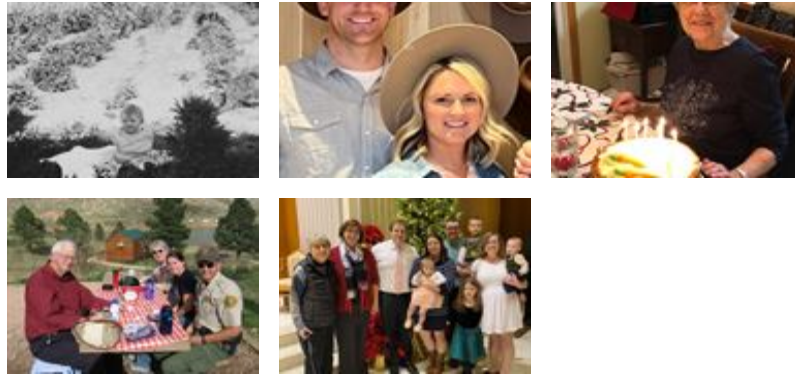
