



Viola "Wienie" Marie Barthel

May 11, 1924 - September 18, 2014

Viola "Wienie" Marie Barthel, age 90, passed away on Thursday, September 18, 2014, at the Golden Valley Manor in Beach, North Dakota. Visitation will be held from 9:00 A.M. until 4:00 P.M. on Monday, September 22, 2014 at the Silha Funeral Home in Beach. A Vigil Service will be at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, September 22, 2014, at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Beach. A Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10:30 A.M. on Tuesday, September 23, 2014, at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church with Father Dan Berg celebrating. Rite of Committal will follow in St. John the Baptist Catholic Cemetery. Silha Funeral Home of Beach has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Wienie was born on May 11, 1924, near Burkey, North Dakota, a daughter of Michael and Susanna (Bertram) Finneman. Wienie was raised in the Burkey area and received her education in the Golva, North Dakota school system and graduated with the Class of 1942. Shortly after her high school education, Wienie married Paul Barthel on November 21, 1944, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Golva, and to this union nine children were born: Julianna, Bob, Marina, Marilyn, Elaine, Mary, Darlene, Sherry, and Ron. They began their married life living on the family farm southeast of Golva and moved to Beach in 1961.

She loved the farming life; especially all the hard work that went into it. She also loved to garden, and canned a lot of what she grew. She especially enjoyed baking and was well-known for her fantastic donuts and dinner rolls.

In her spare time she liked to read magazines, and also play Pinochle and Bingo.

Wienie was a member of the Happy Valley Homemaker's Club, 4-H leader, St. John the Baptist Catholic Church member, and St. Anne's Guild. Church was very important to Wienie and she loved praying the Rosary, attending Mass, and imparting those values onto her children and grandchildren. Her life was her family, and Wienie loved spending as much time with them as she possibly could.

Wienie moved into the Golden Valley Manor in October of 2013, and had resided there until her passing. During her time there, Wienie had received the best care possible.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Michael and Susanna; her husband, Paul; three brothers, Andrew, Buster, and Clarence Finneman; one sister, Marcella Kittel; one infant daughter, Mary; and twin grandsons, Larry and Perry Bares.
