Violet M. Carpenter, age 93, of Glendive, passed away on Wednesday, April 25, 2007 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care Facility. Violet moved to the Extended Care Unit of Glendive Medical Center in October of 2004. She was the last of the original charter members of the Christian Missionary Alliance Church.
