Vonda Marie Stull, age 95, of Wibaux, Montana, passed away on Thursday, November 3, 2016 at the Sidney Health Center Extended Care in Sidney, Montana. Visitation will be held on Sunday, November 6, 2016 from 3:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. at the Silha Funeral Home in Wibaux and one hour prior to services at the church. Vonda was preceded in death by her husband, Willis; her daughter, Bonnie Deckert; her grandson, D.J. Snow and several brothers and sisters.

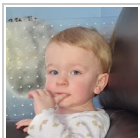
