



Wallace "Wally" Donald Hellesvig

August 29, 1930 - February 2, 2015

Wallace "Wally" Donald Hellesvig, age 84, of Bloomfield, Montana, went home to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Monday, February 2, 2015 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive, Montana. Funeral Services will be held at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday, February 7, 2015 at the Richey Alliance Church in Richey, Montana with Pastor Paul Sponheim officiating. Interment with military honors will be held in the Bethlehem Mennonite Cemetery in Bloomfield. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Wally was born on August 29, 1930 in Penn, North Dakota, a son of Theodore and Emma (Kluffen) Hellesvig, the youngest of six boys. He was raised and educated in North Dakota where he attended high school at Maddock High School graduating with the class of 1948. Wally enjoyed the outdoors and farming, as a teenager he helped cousins on the farm.

Wally was originally supposed to enter the United States Army during the Korean War, but since his mother had already had five sons serving he was not drafted until the Korean War was over. He was drafted into the military in May of 1956 and was honorably discharged in April of 1958. Wally lived in several different locations before settling down in Bloomfield and making that their family home.

Wally met and later married Beverly Knels on June 15, 1968 in Seattle, Washington and to this union two children were born. He was employed with Boeings for twenty-three years before he ended that and decided to farm;

something he'd always enjoyed. Wally continued farming until 2005 when he'd had an accident that fall that caused him to have to retire.

Wally was preceded in death by his parents, Theodore and Emma; siblings, Filloyd, Vernon and Clinton.

He is survived by his loving wife, Beverly Hellesvig of Bloomfield; daughter, Colleen Hellesvig of Phoenix, Arizona; son, Michael Hellesvig of Sidney, Montana; granddaughter, Kasey Day of Sidney; brothers, Roy Hellesvig of Lindstrom, Minnesota and Alvin Hellesvig of Las Vegas, Nevada and numerous nieces and nephews.
