July 18, 1920 - October 23, 2004

Walter L. Lamey, age 84, of Glendive, formerly of Havre and Lakeside, Montana, died on Tuesday, October 19, 2004 at the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive. Memorial Mass will be held at 11:00 A.M., Saturday, October 23, 2004 at the St. Jude's Catholic Church in Havre with Father Jim O'Neil officiating. Rite of Committal with military honors will be in the Highland Cemetery in Havre. Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home of Glendive is entrusted with arrangements. Walter was born on July 18, 1920 in Havre, Montana, the son of John E. and Mary (Kennedy) Lamey. He was raised and educated in Havre, graduating from Havre High School with the class of 1939. He worked for Great Northern Railroad for a couple of years before entering the U.S. Army in 1942. Walter served during World War II in the 8th Air Force. Following his discharge from the military, he was united in marriage to Helen Seeley on December 11, 1945 in Seattle, Washington. Walter and his wife returned to Havre where he again worked for Great Northern/Burlington Northern Railroad until he retired in 1979 after 43 years of service. In 1989, Walter and his wife moved to Lakeside, Montana where they resided until 2000 when they moved to Billings because of medical reasons. During this time, Walter and his wife spent 21 winters in Mesa, Arizona. Walter had been a resident of the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in Glendive for the past two years. Walter was a member of the Knights of Columbus and Havre Eagles Club. Walter enjoyed woodworking, painting and was an accomplished handyman. He was preceded in death by his parents, John and Mary; all of

his siblings, James, Kathleen, John, Joseph, Donald and David Lamey, Margaret Pike and Anne Thompson; great granddaughter, Shelby Molyneaux.
