Walter Maier, age 85, of Glendive, passed away on Tuesday, January 22, 2008 at his home in Glendive. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 P.M., Saturday, January 26, 2008 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Glendive with Pastor James Hageman officiating.
