Wanda Lee (Tobin) Koffler, age 53, of Glendive, Montana passed away on Thursday, June 9, 2016 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. Wanda fought cancer twice in her life and lost her fight to lung cancer after two years of fighting.
