Wanda Seward, age 94 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Tuesday, February 13, 2018 at the Glendive Medical Center Extended Care. Wanda resided in Glendive until the time of her passing.

Wanda enjoyed cooking, sewing, raising flowers and gardening. She liked spending time on the Yellowstone River fishing and picking agates. Wanda also braided many large rugs and loved to do most any hobby crafts. In her

later years she enjoyed putting together jigsaw puzzles.

Wanda was preceded in death by her father, Joseph Roney; step-father, Orlando Larsen; mother, Florence Larsen; husband, Cole Seward; brother, David Roney; twin sister, Juanita Beeler and one great grandchild, Dustin Lane Weinreis.
