Wayne Anthony Weinberger, age 69 of Glendive, Montana passed away on Wednesday, April 22, 2020 at his home surrounded by his family. Visitation will be held from 1:00 PM until 5:00 PM on Tuesday, April 28, 2020 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. Interment with military honors will be at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, April 29, 2020 in the Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive with Pastor Bob Weinberger officiating. Silha Funeral Home of Glendive has been entrusted with the arrangements.

Wayne was born on November 26, 1950 in Mandan, North Dakota to Adam and Monica (Doll) Weinberger. As a young child his family moved to Glendive where Wayne was raised and educated, graduating from Dawson County High School with the class of 1969. Following his education, Wayne enlisted in the United States Army where he served in the Vietnam War and after four years of service, he received his honorable discharge. After his service to his country, Wayne returned to Glendive where he started his career in the oilfield. Wayne worked in many different areas of the oilfield until his retirement in 2016.

Wayne was united in marriage to Kirsten Svingen in 1972 in Glendive and to this union, two children were born. After fourteen years this marriage ended in divorce. In 1990, Wayne was united in marriage to Donna Huffman on August 6, in Coeur D Alene, Idaho.

Wayne enjoyed fishing, agate hunting, collecting antiques and doing yard work. He was a good cook, who enjoyed trying new things and loved grilling

outdoors. Wayne loved time that was spent with his children, grandchildren and brothers.

Wayne was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Donna in 2010 and his brother Arthur Weinberger.

Wayne is survived by his son, Cole (Jennifer) Weinberger of Billings, Montana and their children, Hannah, Alex, Harlan and Billie; his daughter, Amy Weinberger of Glendive and her son Connor Gaughan; two brothers, Vern (RaeDeen) Weinberger of Casa Grande, Arizona and Bob (Janice) Weinberger of Salem, Oregon and numerous nieces and nephews.
