



## William P. "Bill" Bold

August 28, 1927 - January 2, 2007

William P. "Bill" Bold, age 79, of Wibaux, Montana, went home to the Lord on Thursday, December 28, 2006 due to cardiac arrest while he was being treated for cancer at the Glendive Medical Center in Glendive, Montana. Visitation will be on Sunday, December 31, 2006 from 3:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M. in the Chapel of the Silvernale-Silha Funeral Home in Wibaux. A Vigil service will be held at 7:30 P.M., Monday, January 1, 2007 in the St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 A.M., Tuesday, January 2, 2007 in the St. Peter's Catholic Church in Wibaux with Father Denis Fournier officiating. Bill was born on August 28, 1927 in Glendive, Montana, the eldest of four children born to Peter and Germaine (Joubert) Bold. He was raised and educated in Glendive. Bill entered the United States Navy on July 27, 1945 and was honorably discharged on August 4, 1946. Bill was united in marriage to Harriet Jones on November 26, 1946 in Miles City. They settled north of Wibaux where they farmed and raised five children. In 1970, they moved into Wibaux where Bill continued to farm throughout the county. In the fall of 1981 he began working for the City of Wibaux as the Public Works Director, a position he held until his retirement in 1996. Following his retirement, Bill kept busy by helping neighbors with yard work, handyman work and did volunteer work at the Wibaux Cemetery. He especially enjoyed the time he spent visiting with his

family and friends. He was proud of the fact he did the swathing for Rex and Sandy Knight for nine years. This year was the first year he had a swather with air conditioning, cutting over 800 acres. Bill was very loved by his family and friends. He always put others before himself and will be greatly missed. He was preceded in death by his father, Pete and his son, James Bold. Survivors include his wife, Harriet, of Wibaux; his daughters, Sandy Knight and her husband Rex of Wibaux, Diane Conover and her husband Alan of Dillon, Montana, Sherry Saye and her husband Stuart of Billings and Trish Kaufman and her husband Elvie of Lefor, North Dakota; three sisters, Charmaine Holden of Omaha, Nebraska, Joyce Juza and her husband Tom of Wilsonville, Oregon and Delores Dargan of Green Bay, Wisconsin; his mother, Germaine Bold Kramer of Wibaux; 11 grandchildren and six great grandchildren; many nieces and nephews and his special neighbor, James Roberts.
