His idea of a vacation was a trip to the far side of the pasture, watching as new life was born. He truly enjoyed being out on the farm and

participating in everything that went on there. In later years, Bill enjoyed scooter rides through downtown Wibaux. He accepted the realities of the limitations his aging years brought, and he adjusted his life accordingly. Bill is survived by his wife of 38 years, Karin Teeters of Wibaux, Montana; his son, William Frank "Billy" Teeters of Wibaux, Montana; his daughter, Mary Helen Urlacher and her husband Gregg of Regent, North Dakota; his grandchildren, Shelbie Teeters, Stetson Urlacher, Bailey Urlacher, and Jayce Jurgens; and his sister, Marjorie Begger of Chandler, Arizona.
