



## William "Bill" Paul Weidner

June 24, 1940 - December 18, 2017

William "Bill" Paul Weidner, age 77, passed away on Monday, December 18, 2017 at the Eastern Montana Veteran's Home in Glendive, Montana. Visitation will be held from 10:00 A.M. until 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, December 28, 2017 at the Silha Funeral Home in Glendive. A graveside service with military honors will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, December 28, 2017 in Dawson Memorial Cemetery in Glendive. Bill was born on June 24, 1940 in Dodge, North Dakota, a son of Theobolt and Lenchenmee (Maas) Weidner. When Bill was a young child the family moved to Glendive where he was raised and educated, graduating from Dawson County High School with the class of 1959. Following his graduation he enlisted into the U.S. Navy where he served for four years before receiving his honorable discharge in 1963.

After his military service Bill returned home to Glendive where he worked for the Coca-Cola Bottling Company for a couple years before starting work in the construction industry. Bill had found his niche in carpentry and he was a very talented woodworker. He worked various construction jobs across the country until 2002 when his health forced him to retire. During his retirement he resided in Bowman, North Dakota until 2016 when he moved to the Eastern Montana Veteran's Home.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one son, Steve; and six brothers and sisters.

Bill is survived by one son, William Paul Weidner, Jr. of South Dakota; three grandchildren; three step-children; six sisters, Bertha Hegel of Great Falls, Montana, Mardella (Robert) Zinda of Wibaux, Montana, Lorraine Ludwig of Billings, Montana, Deloris Sable of Billings, Viola Ludwig of Billings, and Marie Calvin of Walla Walla, Washington; one brother, Gerald (Carol) Weidner of Wibaux; and numerous nieces and nephews.

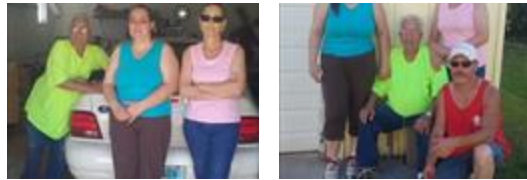
