William "Bill" John Woods, age 56, of Wibaux, Montana, passed away on Wednesday, November 1, 2006 at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. Bill married Bonnie Schulz in New Salem, North Dakota on July 30, 1977. After their marriage they moved to the family farm north of Wibaux, where he resided until the time of his death. Bill was a member of the United Methodist Church of Wibaux and served on the board of Wibaux Co-op Oil Company and was a member of the Wibaux County Weed Board. He loved to read and enjoyed learning everything he could. He also enjoyed photography and

playing cribbage. Bill was always willing and happy to help his neighbors and friends with anything they were doing. He was a quiet and unassuming man who loved spending time with his boys and wife. His family was the most important thing in his life. Bill is preceded in death by his father, Stanley.
